# President's Message by Mary Olson

The Summer Reading Program returns with a full roster of live events at Avenue, E.P. Foster, Hill Road and Saticoy libraries. Favorite performers will visit all four branches and STEAM activities will be offered each week. E.P. Foster Library has initiated a new Graphic Novel book club for 3rd to 6th graders. See pages 3 & 4 for the summer schedules.

Avenue Library will again participate in the California State Library's "Lunch at the Library" program (Monday – Thursday) from 11am – 12 pm. The Farm to Summer program will include daily activities, book giveaways, performers, and speakers to encourage children to come to the library and eat lunch while learning about planting, composting, and the science behind growing food. Call 805 626-READ for start date.

This summer will also see a new School Mobile Library. This second mobile library in the growing library fleet will serve schools through a partnership with the Ventura County Office of Education, bringing a full range of library services, particularly to those in the underserved areas of Ventura County. The School Mobile Library is possible by a generous donation of \$50,000 from the Ventura County Library Foundation and Primary Sponsors: Premier America Credit Union, CBC Federal Credit Union, County Schools Federal Credit Union, and Ventura County Credit Union. This funding is in addition to a \$250,000 Stronger together: Improving Library Access Grant received by the library through the California State Library.

The Library is also offering a Vehicle Day Use Pass for California State Parks. In partnership with California State Parks and the California State Library, free State Parks vehicle-day use passes are available for circulation to help Californians access beautiful parks, lakes, beaches, and monuments in the State Parks system. The Library Parks Pass is valid for vehicle day use at 200+ participating state park units of the California State Park System operated by State Parks. The pass is not valid for per-person entry or tour fees (such as museums), boat use, group use or sites, special events, additional/extra vehicle fees, sanitation disposal use or for supplemental fees. Passes circulate for 21 days and are renewable if no other customers are waiting. For more information, go to https://www.vencolibrary.org/library-things/parks-pass or call 805 626-READ.
